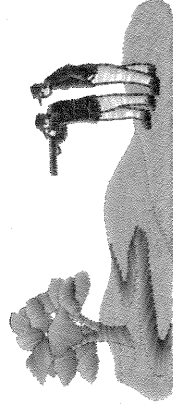

The following information is provided to encourage eligible shooters to participate in this great program.

What is the Scholastic Clay Target Program?

SCTP is a program sponsored by the Amateur Trapshooting Association and the National Shooting Sports Foundation. It is designed to provide school-age youth with the opportunity to enjoy a safe, sanctioned and nationally recognized team sport. It offers participation at the local, state, regional, and national levels.

What are the goals of the SCTP?

Teach the safe and responsible handling and use of firearms; encourage character and citizenship development through teamwork; and provide an introduction to a Lifetime Sport.

Who can participate?

All school-age youth possessing the physical, mental and emotional maturity to participate in a team sport.

How are teams classified?

Teams are divided into divisions -

Rookie - 5th grade

Intermediate - 6th - 8th grade

Senior - 9th - 12th grade

What are the dates of the SCTP program at Powder Creek?

Powder Creek's SCTP trap program will begin around March 22, and run through the 200 target SCTP State Championship on June 7, 2008.

What will it cost me to participate?

Powder Creek is trying to keep its price as low as possible - \$15-\$20 for 50 targets, including shells. This price may vary, depending on the level of outside financial support.
