INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

LIGHTNING POLICY:

Powder Creek does allow shooting in the rain, however, if lightning is present within a ten mile radius of the shooting park all individuals will be asked to vacate the shooting fields and take shelter indoors.

TORNADO POLICY:

If Powder Creek enters a Tornado Warning it will be suggested that all individuals vacate the property and seek shelter elsewhere due to the fact that Powder Creek does not have any form of subterranean basement. If dire circumstances arise and individuals are still on property Powder Creek does have an emergency action plan in place.

WINTER WEATHER POLICY:

If any of the following conditions arise, Powder Creek Shooting Park may not open for daily business:

- 1. If area schools, events, or local roads are closed due to winter weather conditions.
- 2. If there is a weather forecast of:
 - a. Winter weather advisory/warning/alert in effect
 - b. 100% chance of winter precipitation to occur overnight and into the next day
 - c. Extreme frigid temperatures and wind-chills (Management's discretion)
